Tuesday, October 9, 7 PM - 8:30 PM, \$15

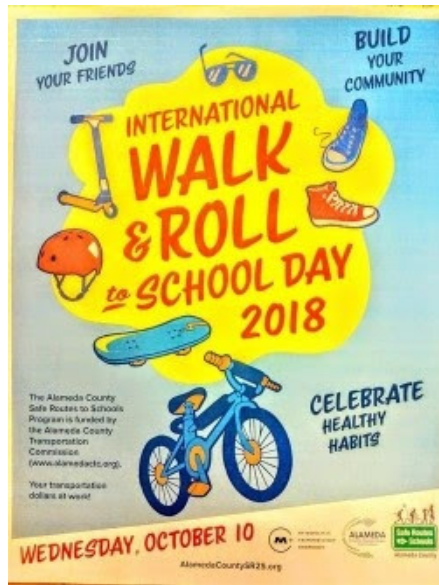
